Maria do Carmo Barreto is Head of the Science and Technology Office at the Azores University and Auxiliary Professor at the Department of Technological Sciences and Development. She graduated in Biology in 1985, at the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Lisbon, and in 1990 concluded the MSc in Biotechnology at Instituto Superior Técnico, in Lisbon. She presented her PhD in Biochemistry at the Azores University in 2000, where she lectures since 1991. Her teaching is mainly in Biochemistry and Enzymology.

Her main research interests lie in the Biological Activity of Natural Products, particularly in activities which indicate pharmacological potential. She also collaborates in the study of anthropogenic and environmental ecotoxicity, mainly concerning biochemical markers and the interaction with enzymes with key roles in metabolism.

She often takes part in scientific divulgation activities, either lecturing or carrying out lab activities, mainly for young people, both at the Azores University and at EXPOLAB Science Center, where she is part of the Scientific Board.
